- Students must **bring in a signed permission slip** on day of event 9/18 (see back)
- A minimum donation of \$10 is required for entry to the event. Students will earn donation thank you from the PTO based on their additional donation levels.\*
  - \$10 donation entry to event
  - \$25+ donation treat handed out at lunch (9/19)
  - \$50+ donation Kona Ice Truck (+ treat, entry)
  - \$100+ donation invitation to get out of class on Friday Sep 20th (+Kona, treat, entry)
  - The teachers with the highest levels of donations will get a \$200 Amazon Gift Card.
  - 78% of students participate on average
  - Students who chose not to participate will be given the opportunity to enjoy other non-instructional activities. Students whose families cannot donate are also provided the opportunity to enjoy the day as the school administration will ensure of this.
